AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM

For Grades K - Young Adult

At Empowering Kids, individuals with autism or social challenges will learn about emotions, managing emotions, problem solving, dealing with peer pressure and ways to build friendships.

Our after school program for elementary and middle school students will include social emotional learning group, snack, homework/reading time, free time, and a monthly outing. High school and young adult programming will include a social emotional learning lesson, transitional programming focusing on independent living skills, fun activities to create connections, and the option to attend a monthly outing to promote friendships and generalization of skills.

Weekly Schedule

- Grades K - 5**
Mondays + Wednesdays, 3:30-5:30pm
- Grades 6 - 10**
Tuesdays + Thursdays, 3:30-5:30pm
- Grades 11 - Young Adult**
Thursdays, 6-8pm

**Between the ages of 2 and 7 years old, no diagnosis is needed to receive services at Empowering Kids. For children ages 7 years and older, we do require a primary diagnosis or educational determination of either autism or ADHD. If your child is not yet able to function in a small group setting, 1:1 services are available to help them establish the necessary skills.

First week of programming is September 9th-13th!

Please Note: To ensure that we have enough staff on hand to provide high quality programming, and to encourage regular attendance, EKP will no longer offer a daily fee. Families can choose to send their child either 1 or 2 days a week, but will be charged the same fee regardless of attendance.
